What needs to be submitted for a Grade 10 Professorial chair promotions case:

- Relevant Job Matching Form (separate matching forms for clinical promotions cases)
- Full CV and Publications List
- Summary CV (Compiled on template)
- Referee Nomination Form

All forms need to be submitted by the local Deanery submission date.

Academic Promotions Process

Stage 1:

In September each year your DoPs are provided an outline of the timeframes for cases to be submitted to the college academic promotions panel.

Stage 2:

Roughly the end of October/Beginning of November is when any promotions cases need to be submitted to your local deanery/school contact.

Stage 3:

Following the submission date the central HR Operations team will compile all the paperwork and send out the requests to your nominated referees..

Stage 4:

The College Promotions Panel is held in roughly March each year. The panel consists of:

Stage 5:

Decisions are provided in writing following the meeting.

Stage 6:

If your case is successful at this stage then your case will be forwarded to be heard at the Central University promotions panel.

Stage 7: Central University Promotions Panel held.

Stage 8: Outcomes provided from the panel.

Stage 9: Potential for appeal.
