

Student Attendance and Monitoring

As Medicine is a professional course, you will find that there are greater demands on your time and more is expected of you than an average student.

We expect you to attend all compulsory teaching, which includes not only lectures but activities such as seminars and PBL sessions. If you are unable to attend due to illness, it is essential that you contact your Year Co-ordinator to let them know you will not be attending. If you are off for more than a week, you will be required to provide a doctor's note (which is why we recommend signing up with the University Health Centre).

If you fail to do this, it will result in a concern being marked on your record. This can have serious implications if this happens more than once.

For international students on a Tier 4 visa, we are required to monitor your attendance through various points in the course. We also hold census points to check your documents and make sure that administrative staff have seen you and can confirm this to UK Visas and Immigration (UKV&I). You will be given more information on this from the International Office.
